3. Tuition and fees typically increase 3–5% annually, effective July 1, pending ACSOM Board approval.
4. Health insurance rate is valid from July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026, and will be updated each academic year.
5. Requests for increased transportation allowance may be approved by the Financial Aid Office with documentation of a round-trip airline ticket.
6. The Graduate Loan Program allows up to \$40,000 per semester. Most students do not borrow the full amount, but if additional funding is needed to meet the full Cost of Attendance, an Institutional Loan may be available. While full funding cannot be guaranteed in every situation, students typically find that available loan options are sufficient to cover their educational expenses.
